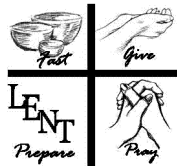
March 19- *Shriners Hospital for Children*—

Transfigured Lord, give me a glimpse of your glory. That is all I ask as I travel with you to the cross this Lent. Amen.

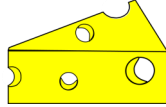
Live the Gospel:
