Holy Thursday: The Washing of Feet:



At the Last Supper, before instituting the Eucharist and entering into His Passion, Jesus washed his Disciples' feet. The washing of feet was considered a degrading act of service, fit for only the lowest servants. Jesus then told His Disciples, "If I, therefore, the master and teacher, have washed your feet, you ought to wash one another's feet. I have given you a model to follow, so that as I have done for you, you should also do." (John 13:14-15) Christ's act of washing feet was a call to serve one another in humility, putting others' needs ahead of our own comfort, convenience, or reputation. Popes have called themselves the "servant of the servants of God" to remind themselves that Christ "did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many." (Matthew 20:28) Let us pray for grace to follow Jesus by pouring out our own lives in loving service of others.

This week, be award of your own moments of faithful surrender. Ask God for the strength to continue moving forward in faith and love, offering your life in whatever ways he asks.

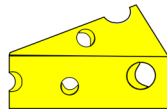

Flower Sale has begun, order forms can be found in the back vestibule. Flowers will be delivered in time for **Mother's Day**. Orders are due by **April 30th**.



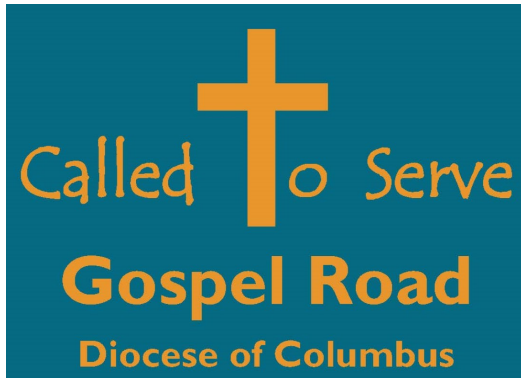
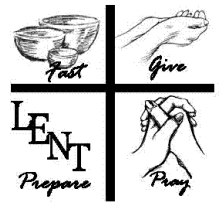
ALMSGIVING

RESTORATION BEGINS on May 1st.

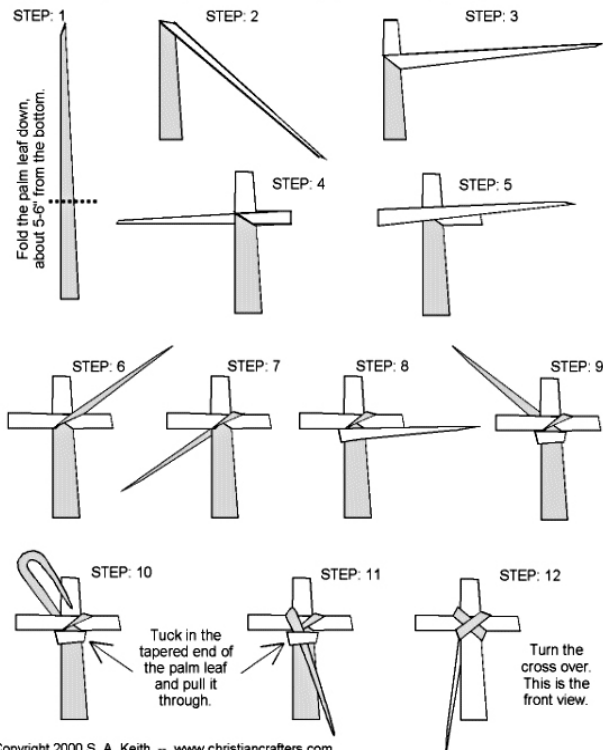
WEEKDAY MASSES will be in the Church Hall beginning on May 1st. The Mass schedule will remain the same.
