Where: Resurrection Parish in Columbus

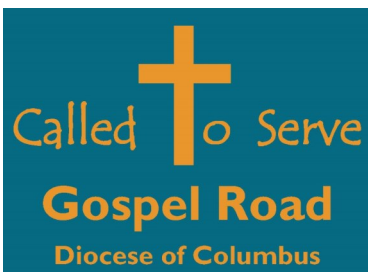
