LOOKING TO MAKE A YEAR-END CONTRIBUTION? On February 2, 1875, the original St. Vincent Orphanage opened its doors to **8 young children**, displaced from their families with no place to call home. A small group of kindhearted nuns managed this special place, dedicated to taking in and taking care of destitute children. **143 years later,** St. Vincent Family Center still serves as a special place devoted to caring for children and families in desperate need of hope and support. Only now, they provide care to **over 5,000 children** every year – in their building and throughout our community. The winter months are now in full force, and the Orphanage turned Family Center is in need of a desperate upgrade – a **new boiler**. The ADAMH Board of Franklin County **will match** all contributions 50:50 to defray the cost of this urgent capital need. The Catholic Foundation has agreed to **grant \$20,000.00** which leaves an **additional \$20,000.00 to be raised**.
