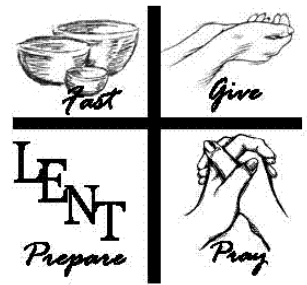

LENTEN ALMSGIVING

During Lent, we are asked to focus more intently on "almsgiving," which means donating money or goods to the poor and performing other acts of charity. As one of the three pillars of Lenten practice, almsgiving is "a witness to fraternal charity" and "a work of justice pleasing to God." (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, no. 2462).



PSR Students will be participating in **Lenten Almsgiving**: To promote Almsgiving among our youth, we will be collecting items for different groups/organizations each week.

Week 1: March 10: Hope House: dish soap, laundry detergent, bleach, fabric softener, paper towels, first aid supplies, personal care items, coffee, peanut butter, crackers, canned meats, cereal, pasta & pasta sauce, soup, bottled water, individually wrapped snacks.

Week 2: March 17: Food Pantry—non-perishable food items: peanut butter, can fruit and vegetables, can soup, boxes of mac-n-cheese, cereal, and canned meats.

Week 3: March 24 Haven House: women's razors and deodorant, toilet paper, body wash, shampoo, laundry detergent, tooth brushes & tooth paste, and hair brush/combs.

Week 4: March 31: Elizabeth Hope: baby diapers (any size), baby onesies, sleepers.

Week 5: April 7: VA Men's shelter: deodorant, toilet paper, razors & shaving cream, shampoo, paper towels, and socks,

Week 6: April 14: Gospel Road Mission Trip: paint brushes, painter's tape, roller pan liners, roller pads, paper towels, drop clothes, and lawn bags.

All through Lent—CRS Rice Bowls: monetary donations. Bowls to be returned to the church on Sunday, April 21 or April 28.
