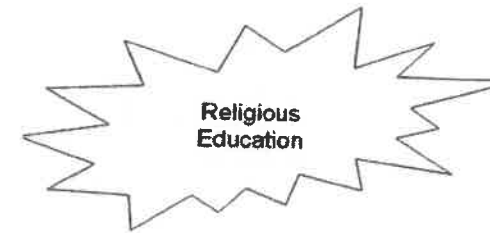
ALL weekend masses, including daily masses and Communion Services resume at St. Patrick's beginning next weekend!
