CONGRATULATIONS BISHOP-ELECT LUCIA

(June 19 Edition, North Country Catholic)

Pope Francis has appointed a priest of the Diocese of Ogdensburg to be the new bishop for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse. Bishop-elect Douglas Lucia will become the 11th bishop of Syracuse, succeeding Bishop Robert J. Cunningham. Bishop-elect Lucia grew up in Altona with his siblings. He will be ordained and installed at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Syracuse on Aug. 8. Due to the capacity and related safety concerns, this event is by invitation only. However, there will be a Mass of Thanksgiving at the Church of the Holy Angels, Altona on September 1 at 10:00am. Bishop-elect Lucia will be the shepherd of over 220,000 Catholics covering 5,479 square miles. We wish him well.
