REFLECTION: Pentecost

Today we celebrate the birth of the Church when the disciples left the upper room and fearlessly went about preaching the gospel and converting people to be followers of Christ. The Holy Spirit empowered them to go out and proclaim the Good News to all the nations. We are beneficiaries of this work of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is also with us now eagerly waiting to use us to proclaim the Good News to others.

As we celebrate the anniversary of the birth of this new community of Christ, let us remember that we have received the Holy Spirit too and need to share the Good News with others. Differences in language might be a barrier for us to preach the gospel to people of other nations, but there is still a particular language which everyone understands – the language of good work, the act of love. May we also remember that we can only stand firm as a community of Christ if we always see ourselves as brothers and sisters in the Lord and not as rivals.
