The March will include a rally featuring keynote speaker Dr. Monica Miller. Monica Migliorino Miller, Ph. D. is a nationally-known pro-life leader, founder and director of Citizens for a Pro-Life Society, active in the pro-life movement since 1976. ### Epiphany of the Lord Year C

When the magi who I might call men of mystery because of their mysterious discovery of the baby Jesus visited the Baby, they gave the baby Jesus precious gifts that have great significance. They gave Jesus the expensive gifts of Gold, Frankincense, and Myrrh and prostrated before Jesus and paid him homage. These gesture by the magi signify the greatness of Jesus and how He deserves the best gifts. Jesus is among us today in different ways. How do we acknowledge His importance? Do we pay Him homage? What kind of gifts do we give Him? As we reflect on these questions, I would suggest that we think of those things in the Bible that are important to Jesus. Example, the Beatitudes, the golden rule, the greatest commandment – Love of God and neighbor, and His comments in Mathew chapter 25: 35-40 where he listed a couple of things and said that whenever we do these to the least of His brethren, we did them to Him. His brethren are in our communities, churches, and all over the world. We also need to respect His presence in the Holy Eucharist.
