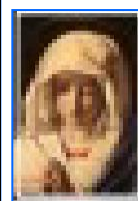
KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

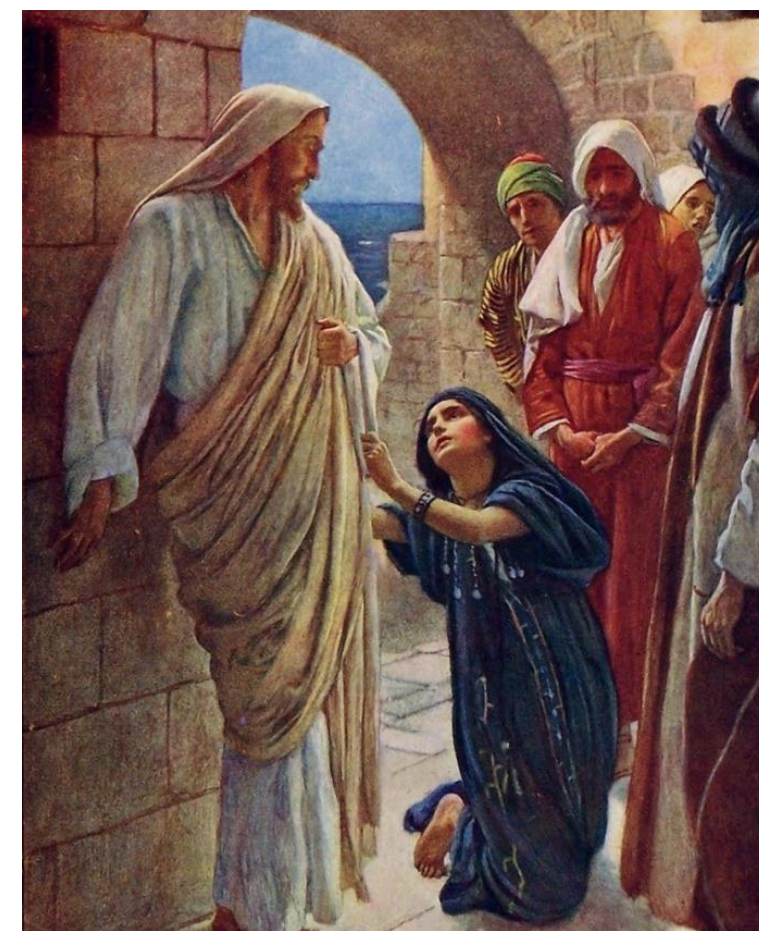
