### THIRTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME November 4, 2018



*"Love the Lord with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength"*

*Mark 12:28-34*

*And one of the scribes came up and heard them disputing with one another, and seeing that he answered them well, asked him, "Which commandment is the first of all?" Jesus answered, "The first is, 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one; and you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.' The second is this, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these." And the scribe said to him, "You are right, Teacher; you have truly said that he is one, and there is no other but he; and to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the strength, and to love one's neighbor as oneself, is much more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices." And when Jesus saw that he answered wisely, he said to him, "You are not far from the kingdom of God." And after that no one dared to ask him any question.*

*Meditation: What is the purpose of God's law or commandments? The Pharisees prided themselves in the knowledge of the law and their ritual requirements. They made it a life-time practice to study the 613 precepts of the Old Testament along with the numerous rabbinic commentaries. They tested Jesus to see if he correctly understood the law as they did. Jesus startled them with his profound simplicity and mastery of the law of God and its purpose.*

*Our love for God is a response to his exceeding grace and kindness towards us  
What does God require of us? Simply that we love as he loves! God is love and everything he does flows from his love for us. God loved us first and our love for him is a response to his exceeding grace and kindness towards us. The love of God comes first and the love of neighbor is firmly grounded in the love of God. The more we know of God's love and truth the more we love what he loves and reject what is hateful and contrary to his will.*

**REFLECTION**

"What do you want Me to do for you?" He said, "Lord, that I may receive my sight." —Luke 18:41

The blind man in this reading wanted Jesus to restore his sight. That's something that seemed impossible to those in the crowd, and many of us in today's world would tell the man he could overcome blindness on his own.

But Jesus understood the man was not asking for the impossible. The man believed all things are possible through God. For that reason, Jesus called him forward.

There are many people in our lives today who don't focus on their problems, but rather their relationship with God. They strive at doing what they can do instead of what they cannot.

For God to have pity on us, we must first fully believe that all things are possible through Him. We are not alone in any situation as long as we believe in God.

**MARRIAGE MINUTE**

Many faithful parents will lament the loss of extended prayer time because of a chaotic family schedule. Thinking about the devotional practices they were able to maintain as a single, some even go so far as to doubt that they landed in the right vocation.
