VCS is participating in the Adopt-A-Floor Program at Children's of Mississippi (Blair Batson Hospital) On July 10, 2018, and we would love for the parishioners to donate as well. The Adopt-A-Floor program provides snacks to the families of patients. Families faced with a health crisis for a child are faced with not only physical setbacks but financial setbacks as well and this is a wonderful way for us to help them through the journey.

Each floor needs at least 350 snacks weekly to provide to the families of sick children and our goal is to provide an entire month of snacks for our floor. We are asking students and families to donate pre-packaged, non-expired, individually wrapped snacks.

Due to the school being closed the week of July 4th, ALL DONATIONS ARE NEEDED BY THURSDAY, JUNE 28 AT 11:00AM. Donations may be delivered to the St. Aloysius High School office beginning Monday, June 25, 2018 at 8:00am until 11:30am.

Here is a suggested list of snacks:

Soup (pop-top lids only), Fruit Bowls, Crackers, Granola Bars, individual Mac & Cheese, Chicken Salad/Cracker Combination, Tuna Salad/Cracker Combination, Baked Chips/Pretzels/Pita Chips, Individual Cereal Cups/Oatmeal & Grits Cups, Popcorn, Pickles, Shelf Stable meals such as Healthy Choice Fresh Mixers, Breakfast Bars and Coffee. St. Aloysius students will receive 15 minutes of service for each pre-packaged item delivered.

VICKSBURG CATHOLIC SCHOOL SERVICE -On July 10, 2018, The Mother Teresa Tuesday activity, sponsored by Vicksburg Catholic School in partnership with Families First for Mississippi, will be in the Jackson area. It will be an all-day excursion open to rising students in grades 7-12 in our community. Transportation will be provided by the VCS bus and all students must turn in a completed field trip permission slip before boarding the bus. The bus will depart promptly at 9:00am from the school parking lot. Please eat breakfast before coming, lunch, however will be provided.

Our first stop will be to deliver the snacks collected for Blair Batson (2500 North State Street) Adopt-A-Floor program at 10:00am. After delivering items, we will then travel to Canton, Mississippi and work at Our Daily Bread, 313 West Franklin Street (ourdailybreadms.org). We will be serving food to approximately 90 people in need including school children as well as help to organize their storage pantry. We will arrive back at VCS by 4:00pm.
