Although the belief that Mary was sinless, or conceived without original sin, has been widely held since Late Antiquity, the doctrine was not dogmatically defined in the Catholic Church until 1854 when Pope Pius IX, declared ex cathedra, i.e., using papal infallibility, in his papal bull *Ineffabilis Deus*^[2] the Immaculate Conception to be doctrine. THE SOULS OF OUR DEPARTED LEGIONARIES

The end of the campaigning has come and a legionary lies nobly dead. Now at last he is confirmed in legionary service. Through all eternity he will be a legionary, for the Legion has shaped that eternity for him. It has been the fiber and the mold of his spiritual life. Moreover, the might of the united petition, uttered daily and earnestly by active members and auxiliaries alike, that the Legion should reassemble without the loss of any one, has helped him through the dangers and the difficulties of the long way. What a joyful thought for all legionaries — on his account and on their own! But for the moment, there is sorrow at the loss of friend and comrade, and there is need of prayer so that the deliverance of the departed soldier from the realm of Purgatory may be speedily accomplished.

The praesidium should without delay have a Mass offered for the soul of each one of its active members who may die; and each member of that praesidium should specially recite all the legion prayers, inclusive of the rosary, at least once for the same intention. But these duties do not extend to the deceased relatives of members. As many legionaries as possible, and not those of the particular praesidium alone, should attend the Mass and accompany the remains to burial. It is recommended that the rosary and other legion prayers should be recited while the interment is actually taking place. This could be done immediately after the official prayers of the Church. This practice, besides being of much benefit to the deceased, will be found to be a source of deep consolation to the sorrowing relatives, to the legionaries themselves, and to all the friends present. It is trusted that the same prayers will have been said more than once beside the remains during the period of laying out. Nor should the duty of remembrance be deemed then to cease. In the month of November each year, each praesidium shall have a Mass celebrated for the souls of the legionary dead, not of that praesidium alone but of all the world. In this, as on all other occasions where prayer is offered for departed legionaries, all grades of membership are comprised.

"Purgatory forms part of the realm of Mary. There, too, are her children, who in a passing spell of pain await their birth to the glory which will never pass. St. Vincent Ferrer, St. Bernardine of Siena, Louis de Blois, as well as others, explicitly proclaim Mary to be Queen of Purgatory; and St. Louis-Marie de Montfort urges us to think and act in accordance with that belief. He wishes us to place in Mary's hands the value of our prayers and satisfactions. He promises us that, in return for this offering, those souls which are dear to us will be more abundantly relieved than if we were to apply our prayers to them directly." ALLOCUTIO

Every day we wake up we can make a difference for the Kingdom. Does that move you? It is easy for us to fall into routine and do our prayers out of duty. But do we really pray? Their works Nursing homes are visited and the hospital visits are made. Rosary is prayed weekly with residents from one nursing home.

SPANISH COMITIUM Nuestra Señora Reina Y Madre

In August, we had a meeting for curiae and praesidia officers. Sr. Lydia was part of our team, She clarified some questions members had and encouraged us to continue with our work. Special Reports: Enthronements: During this period, our Comitium had 106, Curia Inmaculado Corazon de Maria 27, Curia Reina del Santisimo Rosario 47, Curia Nuestra Señora de la Asuncion 41, Curia Reina de la Paz 54, Curia Madre del Salvador 20, with a grand total of 292 enthronements. Door - to -Door: our Comitium had 305, Curia Inmaculado Corazon de Maria had 33, Curia Reina del Santisimo Rosario 222, Curia Nuestra Señora de la Asuncion 3, Curia Reina de la Paz 1,561, Curia Madre del Salvador 80. This is a grand total of 2,174 door-to-door in the past 3 months. Auxiliary Members: our Comitium had 48, Curia Inmaculado Corazon de Maria 25, Curia Reina del Santisimo Rosario 23, Curia Nuestra Señora de la Asuncion 55, Curia Reina de la Paz 60, Curia Madre del Salvador 5. This is a total of 216 new auxiliary members. Reports: For this period, we had 2 adult praesidia, 1 junior praesidia, and 4 Curiae. Praesidium **Madre de la Gracia** (St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, Houston, TX) has 10 active members and 35 auxiliaries. They had 41 enthronements, 52 rosaries at home with the pilgrim Virgin, they say rosaries at funerals, and 325 door to door. They bring the Eucharist to the homebound. Their highlight is that they have had many street contacts by going standing outside of a Hispanic store and talk to the clientele. **Rosa Escogida** (St. Bartholomew, Katy, TX) has 12 active members, 3 on probation, 118 auxiliaries, and 2 adjutons. They visited 60 homes with the pilgrim Virgin and had 50 enthronements. They visited the sick and the elderly 84 times, had 3 street contacts, and 3 extension days. Junior Praesidium **En los brazos de Maria** (SL Bartholomew, Katy, TX) has 12 active members between 4 and 7 years old. They celebrate different feast related to our Blessed Mother, the Sacred Heart of Jesus, Lent, and Christmas. For example, during lent they were encouraged to do a small sacrifice every week. The last project to make a scapular of our Blessed Mother. They are quickly learned how to say the Rosary. **Inmaculado Corazon de Maria Curia Quarterly Report.**

1 adult praesidium and 2 junior praesidia: Junior praesidium **Nuestra Señora del Santísimo Sacramento**, Corpus Christi Parish has 11 active members, 3 of them are altar servers. This year 3 of them moved to the Junior praesidia for older members. They have a spiritual director, Fr. Ravi Ernest. They give miraculous medals, they recruit 3 auxiliaries.

Junior praesidium **Soldados Valientes de Jesús y María** Corpus Christie Parish. They have 21 members 1 auxiliary, 6 members are on probation, 13 of these members are altar servers. They attend the meeting regularly, persevere, and collaborate with the community. Also, Fr. Ravi is their spiritual director. They have participated in different events from the Archdiocese. Three of them are discerning their vocation. Praesidium **Mother of Good Counsel**, St. Dominic, has 7 active members and 58 auxiliaries. They visited 11 homes, had 6 enthronements, visited the nurse home 66 times, as well as the elderly and homebound 183. They had 32 door-to-door and pray the rosary in 7 wakes in funeral homes. The Curia has been asked to form a praesidium in Immaculate Heart of Mary Church. They will start in November.

Nuestra Señora De La Asuncion Curia Quarterly Report: They reported on three adult praesidia. Praesidium **Estrella de la Manana** (St. Mary of the Miraculous Medal Church, Texas City, TX), has 9 active members and 15 auxiliaries. They had 8 rosaries at homes, 7 enthronements, visited the hospital 17 times and the nurse home 47 times. They had 8 street contacts. Praesidium **Madre de la Divina Gracia**, (True Cross Church, Dickinson, TX) has 6 active members and 80 auxiliaries. They have visited 50 homes with the Virgin statue, pray 6 rosaries at wakes, they had 35 enthronements, visited the elderly 56 times. Also, they had street contacts and supported regularly the La Marque praesidium. Praesidium **Reina de la Paz** (Queen of Peace, La Marque, TX) has 7 active members, 7 auxiliaries, and 1 on probation. They have one pilgrim Virgin Statue and visited 41 homes. They had 23 enthronements and brought the Eucharist 39 times. They had 3 recruitments and 17 street contacts. They supported the parish in different events.

The Curia is in the process of recruitment for the junior praesidium. They had one but had to close it due to youth going to College. They will continue supporting the new praesidium in Manvel as well as visiting two praesidia per month. **Reina del Santísimo Rosario Curia Quarterly Report:** Praesidium **Reina de la Paz**, (Assumption Church, Houston, TX) has 9 active members, 1 on probation, and 22 auxiliaries. They visited 18 homes with the pilgrim Virgin statue and had 18 enthronements. They visited the sick at home and in hospitals. They had 170 door-to-door. They have two different locations where they have the book barrow. Praesidium **Maria Madre de los Huerfanos** (Assumption Church, Houston, TX) has 4 active members on probation and 18 auxiliaries. They had 40 door-to-door. They visit the elderly and the sick in their homes. They have a book barrow. They supported the curia and the parish activities. Praesidium **Madre del Salvador** (St. Monica Church, Houston, TX) has 9 active members and 5 auxiliaries. They visited 26 homes with the pilgrim Virgin and had 21 enthronements. They had, 14 door-to-door and 165 street contacts. They visited the elderly and the sick in their homes. Praesidium **Trono de la Sabiduría** (San Carlos Bonomeo Church, Houston, TX) has 4 active

members, 1 on probation, and 28 auxiliaries. They visited 36 homes with the pilgrim Virgin and had 10 enthronements. They had 14 door-to-door and 278 street contacts. They visited the elderly and the sick in hospitals. Praesidium **Puerta del Cielo** (Resurrection Church, Houston, TX) has 13 active members, 1 on probation, and 28 auxiliaries. They visited 23 homes and had 17 enthronements. They visited the elderly in their homes. Their future plans are to open a junior praesidium in St. Martin de Pones Church, recruit more members. They have several officer vacancies. **Reina De La Paz Curia Quarterly Report:** 3 adult praesidia: Praesidium **Maria Gonsuelo de los Afligidos** (Holy Ghost, Houston, TX) has 6 active members, 2 on probation, 46 auxiliaries. They have 4 pilgrim Virgin hat visited 27 homes and had 23 enthronements. They visited the elderly, the sick in hospitals, and the jail. They had 21 street contacts and 11 visits to the prison. They prayed at wakes and novenas. They are looking for a place to have a book barrow. Praesidium **Maria Auxiliadora** (St. Thomas More, Houston, TX) has 1 active members, and 23 auxiliaries. They have 3 pilgrim Virgin statues and have visited 53 homes, had 34 enthronements. They have had 336 door-to-door and 17 street contacts. They are in the process of having a book barrow. Praesidium **Reina de la Paz** (Notre Dame, Houston, TX) has 7 active members and 27 auxiliaries. They have 4 pilgrim Virgin statues, visited 34 homes, and had 20 enthronements. They visit the sick and, in some occasions, brought holy communion. The Curia's future plans are to support the praesidia and continue praying for a Spiritual Director, and continue visiting our praesidia. **Madre Del Salvador Curia Quarterly Report:** They have a new Spanish praesidium in Huntsville. They will support this praesidium, as well as the new one in St. Mary Magdalen Church in Humble.
