While the school recognizes that it does not have control of the information students may find while conducting research on the Internet, a conscious effort is made to protect our students through internet filtering and education of appropriate use.

What are the consequences for failing to abide by the BYOD Student Code of Conduct?

1st Offense: Personal Device will be confiscated and placed in a secure location where the owner can retrieve it at the end of the day

2nd Offense: User will lose the privilege to have a personal device for 2 weeks.

3rd Offense: Personal Device will be confiscated and placed in the office where a parent will be required to come to school to retrieve it.
