About the Guest Speaker

Tyler VanderWeele is the John L. Loeb and Frances Lehman Loeb Professor of Epidemiology at the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health and the director of the Program on Integrative Knowledge and Human Flourishing at Harvard's Institute for Quantitative Social Science. He grew up in a Christian home and was received in the Catholic Church in 2012. He and his wife Lisa and their son Jonathan are parishioners at St. Paul's Church. His research concerns methodology for distinguishing between association and causation in observational studies, and his empirical research spans psychiatric, perinatal, and social epidemiology; the science of happiness and flourishing; and the study of religion and health, including both religion and population health and the role of religion and spirituality in end-of-life care. He is interested in bringing ideas from Christian theology into dialogue with public health thinking and practice.
