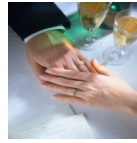

“ST. MARY’S SCRIP PROGRAM”

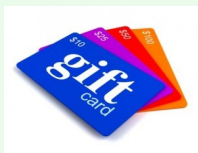
