This year we will be celebrating 106 years of providing outstanding education in Sheridan. It is well known that Holy Name Catholic School is one of the best schools in the state of Wyoming. Please review the dress code. It is online and in the student handbook. A quick summary... students are required to wear embroidered red, white or navy logo shirts three days a week: Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday.
