Mission Appeal

On the weekend of August 3 & 4, at all Masses, Rev. Msgr. Eugene Pereira will be speaking about the works and the needs of the Latin Archdiocese of Trivandrum in India. This appeal is done throughout our archdiocese of Ottawa to help raise awareness of those most in need in other countries. Any donation given to this worthwhile cause is **not tax deductible as the charity is not recognized by the Canada Revenue Agency.**

Trivandrum has about 270,000 Catholics. 90% of the people are traditional fishermen who depend on fishing for their livelihood and 10% are farm workers who are recent converts from low caste Hindus. Unemployment and poverty are most rampant in this community. The Archdiocese depends on outside assistance to support its clergy, seminarians, Catechists and to continue its developmental programs for the Community. However, on November 30, 2017 several coastal villages of the Archdiocese were hit by Cyclone "Ockhi". More than 289 young fishermen drowned in the sea while doing deep sea fishing. There is so much sadness and devastation in their villages. Many young Catholic families lost their men and everything they had owned. We are looking for emergency assistance to help the children especially, with food, clothing and shelter. Your sacrifice for the Missions is very much appreciated and may God bless you.
