From Father Mike

I think we would all agree that if you go into a convent and are around the nuns that live there, you would not only feel that you were in the presence of a group of holy women but that the whole place would have the sense of holiness. Yet, what would make these persons dedicated to the Lord any different than us living together in our grouping as a family? Why wouldn't our homes have the same sense of holiness as an institutional building of religious women? Pope Francis in his writings on the family has been promoting the idea of the holiness of the domestic church. He asserts that our family life is just as sacred as our parish community or universal church, the only difference is with size of this level of church and not the sanctity of it. One example of the holiness of the domestic church is to think of how a married couple or parents can make the home a confessional, where a person's mistakes are acknowledged, forgiven, and then used to learn from them so that everyone can improve themselves as disciples of the Lord as well as loving human beings. My prayer is that we don't look at the Holy Family whom we commemorate today as an impossible ideal but as our intercessors to help our own families to continually grow in faith. Then we can give praise and worship to the Lord in our homes as well as our churches.

MASS FOR MARY, MOTHER OF GOD

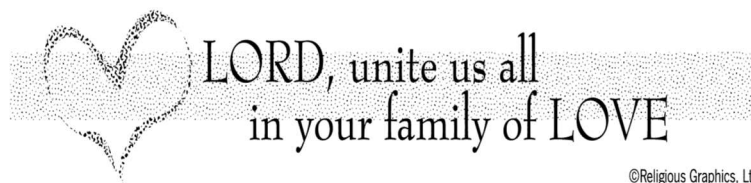
