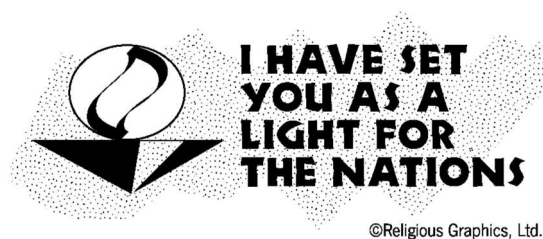
## RELIC OF ST. JOHN VIANNEY

### ***From Father Mike***

Today we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, when we can use this last day of the Christmas Season to appreciate even more our own baptism. As a baptized people, we almost always begin the Eucharistic Prayer with the words, "It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks, Lord, holy Father, almighty and eternal God, through Christ our Lord." And the first gift from God that we are all grateful for is the gift of life. Since God is good, that means no matter the condition of our bodies or what is happening in our lives, our life is a gift. Baptism is our immersion in the grace of Jesus that saves from our thinking that our lives do not matter. It is the essential means of discovering and living out the uniqueness that our life is meant to have for making the world a better place. It is vital that we stay rooted in our baptismal graces when often we are being told that we are inadequate. We are receiving messages about being too thin and/or too fat or having imperfect skin, dull teeth, outdated clothes, or frizzy hair in order that we might buy something that make us "better," which implies it will thus make us happy. Baptism has already allowed us to be our most perfect selves as God created us to be and has given us access to divine joy, regardless of our various physical attributes. That is something for which we can indeed be truly thankful.
