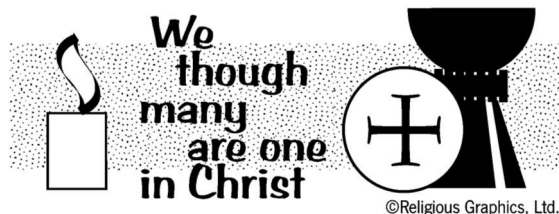

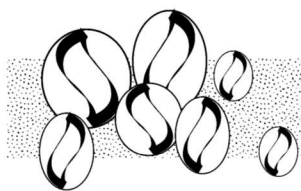

From Father Mike

Today's second reading is a beautiful reflection on the effects of baptism for each of us and for the wider church: "As a body is one though it has many parts, and all the parts of the body, though many, are one body, so also Christ." Even though each person baptized increases the size of the church, the Body of Christ is more than a club of Catholics that gains more members. The living organism that is the church here on earth is the ongoing presence of Christ in the world, made more perfect when each of us who are baptized fully cooperate with the grace of this sacrament. One effect of having more members of this body is also having a greater diversity within the Church. While this can be more of a challenge in maintaining our unity in Christ, nevertheless I am convinced that increasing the ethnic, generational, and economic variety of households in Catholic parishes is what is making us a stronger, more vibrant, and dynamic faith family. This mixture of peoples is what is allowing us to have a better "full body" experience of being the Body of Christ and a more complete presence of the Risen Lord in our world.
