During the Lenten Season, come pray the Stations of the Cross each Friday at 5:00pm in the church.

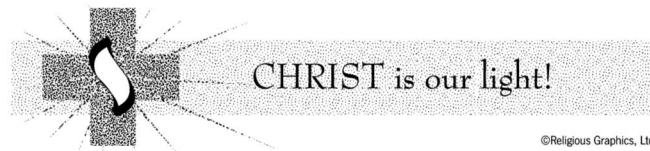

From Father Mike

“Our citizenship is in heaven,” begins Paul in today’s second reading to the Philippians. The residents of the city of Philippi were Greeks occupied by the Romans and populated with a small group of Jews. They were the first European city to be evangelized by Paul. These Jewish Christians already had a sense of living in one culture (Greek), having the religious sensibility of another (Judaism), and then having to deal with yet another one imposed from beyond their borders (Roman). Regardless of which country is on our passport, we all can relate to the experience that being a Christian in this county has an element of feeling out of place in our modern society. As citizens of heaven, our values and actions will be in conflict at times with those around us. This is no surprise since our modern world seems to default to relativism, individualism, and materialism, all of which oppose the values of the Gospels. Lent is when we renew our commitment to the Kingdom of God as part of our participation in Christ’s resurrection, understanding that we will always feel out of place in this earthly realm. It is why today’s gospel is the story of the Transfiguration, a story of encouragement to all disciples as it reminds us of Jesus’ promise that we are meant to share in his heavenly glory. May this holy season help us go beyond any awkwardness that inevitably comes from contradicting worldly values in order to have total confidence in Christ our Savior as citizens of heaven.

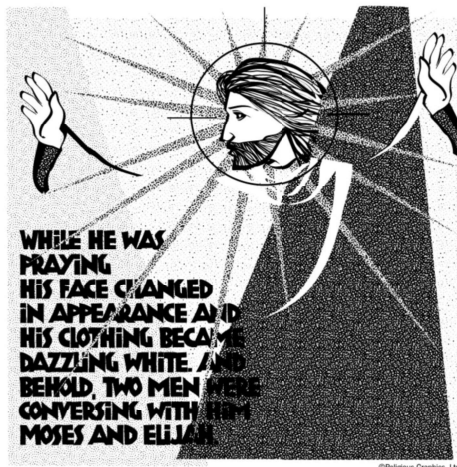
