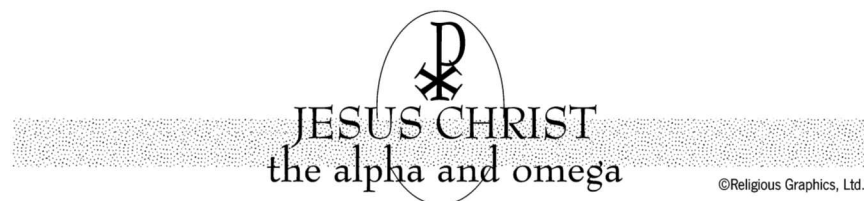

From Father Mike

On the second Sunday of Easter, we hear every year from chapter 20 of John's gospel. It is the familiar story often titled, "Doubting Thomas," when Jesus appeared to the apostles right after his resurrection. Nevertheless, the three year cycle of readings gives us different scripture passages for the first and second readings, and this year we have the first reading from Acts of the Apostles, chapter 5. It shows how the early church continued the ministry of Jesus, including his healing outreach. Most incredibly, this passage from Acts describes how "they even carried the sick out into the streets and laid them on cots and mats so that when Peter came by, at least his shadow might fall on one or another of them." The same healing shadow is cast by us as members of the Church who continue to be the presence of Christ in these present times. Just like Peter, we are instruments of the healing ministry of Jesus. Consider all those persons of faith, both members of your own family and many others, who have been channels of Christ's healing for you. If so many others have been used by God for you, why wouldn't God have used and is still using you to also extend his merciful hand of healing to others? For this we not only celebrate Easter but are Easter for each other!
