### *From Father Mike*

In today's celebration of the Solemnity of the Ascension, our first reading from the Acts of the Apostles recalls the taking up of Jesus to heaven. He reminds his disciples, "...you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Remember that what is true for the first disciples has to be equally true for us since we were all baptized in the same Holy Spirit. While we don't live anywhere near Jerusalem, Judea, or Samaria, we do live in this part of the world to be witnesses to the resurrection. One of the things with which we as Catholics need to get more comfortable is our own relationship with the Risen Christ and developing the stories of those specific times we have experienced his presence, his power, his grace, and his mercy. Everyone tells stories of something that happened to them last week or many years ago, so we all can share those times that Jesus did something wonderful in our lives. The next step is to not be afraid to share those stories with others as those opportunities present themselves. Practice with your family or others in the parish by simply talking about the last time you felt close to Jesus. Remember, you have already received the power to be a witness because the Holy Spirit has come upon you!
