#### From Father Mike

I have been alerting you to the Uniting in Heart 2030 Pastoral Plan that began to be publicized last week. Right now the plan is in draft form, so I urge you to look it over because everyone is also invited to provide their feedback. You can see it online at www.dol-in.org\uniting-in-heart. The Catholic Moment will have this information in next week's issue as well. Additionally, conversations will be begin soon on how we will be implementing this plan locally, and it is important to note some of the following items as we get ready for that process. First, the plan was based on data on parish and local area demographics, finances, and trends. I appreciate that we are moving beyond our own limited experiences and perceptions of what we think is happening and invited to consider a thorough analysis of the current reality throughout our entire diocese. Second, it takes into account the aging and wellness of our priests. You will see this most especially in the requirement that no priest will be expected to celebrate more than three Masses each weekend. Third, the plan is rooted in a vision to grow in our individual relationship with Christ and our collective outreach to others to become fellow disciples of the Lord and our service to the wider communities in which we live, especially to the poor around us. I am grateful that we will be even more focused on our core mission as church and better coordinated, trained, and resourced to accomplish our purpose. Paul summarizes our mission so eloquently in today's second reading: "For you were called for freedom, brothers and sisters. But do not use this freedom as an opportunity for the flesh; rather, serve one another through love."


