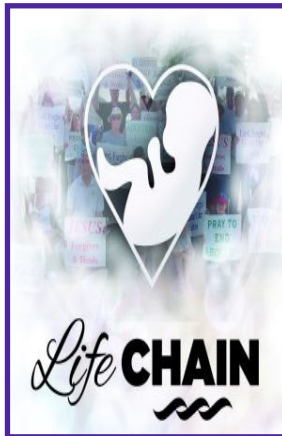

RESPECT LIFE ♦ LIFE CHAIN

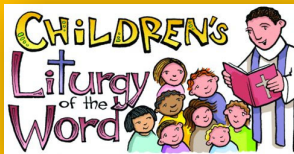
