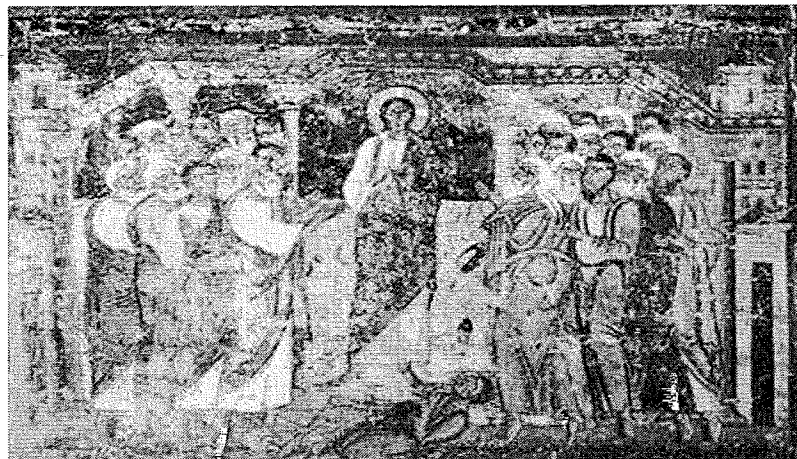

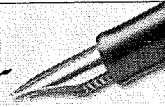
Mission Statement
