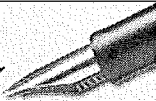
Mission Statement

Dear Parishioners,
 February is designated as "Catholic Press Month". Therefore it is the time when we ask parishioners to support the publication and distribution of The Catholic Moment, the newspaper of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana. Technically no one subscribes to The Catholic Moment. Approximately 30 years ago Bishop Higi decided that every household registered in a parish of our diocese would receive The Catholic Moment. Bishop Higi saw this as a valuable evangelization tool. At that time many parish priests, certainly myself included, were very skeptical about the value of sending The Catholic Moment to every parishioner's home. However, I personally know people who have returned to the practice of their faith at least in part because of things they have read in The Catholic Moment. Our parish pays \$22 per year for every copy of The Catholic Moment sent to a parishioner's home. I encourage you to use the envelope in your packet to help the parish to pay the cost of the copy of The Catholic Moment which you receive and possibly the copy of someone else.

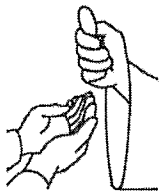

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION FOR CHILDREN

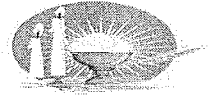
In order for your children to celebrate the sacraments of

Seven Deadly Sins, Seven Lively Virtues

We will show this in two parts

Join Bishop Robert Barron for this engaging
presentation concerning the seven deadly sins,
those great spiritual blocks that inhibit our flourish-
ing in relationship with God and one another.
Based on Dante's writings, the seven deadly
sins correspond to the seven stories of Dante's
Mt. Purgatory. Pride, envy, anger, sloth,
gluttony, avarice and lust are all presented as
patterns of dysfunction within us that lead to
unhappiness.

However, Bishop Barron shows us how to
counteract these seven sinful patterns through
a conscious process of opposition, which are
the "seven lively virtues." The seven lively vir-
tues offer antidotes to each sin and help set us
on the right path to healing and happiness.
