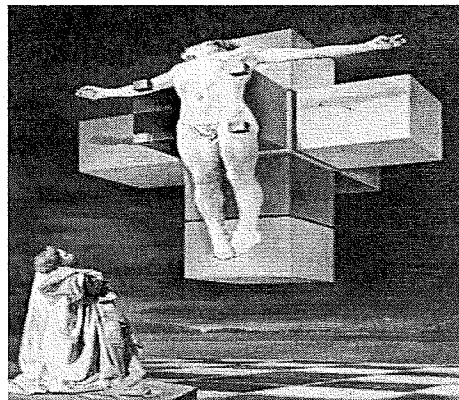

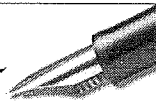
Mission Statement

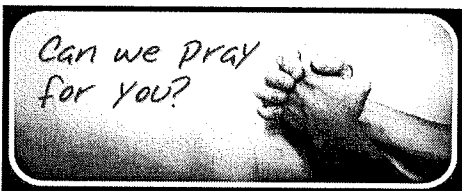

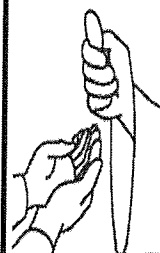
SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION FOR CHILDREN
