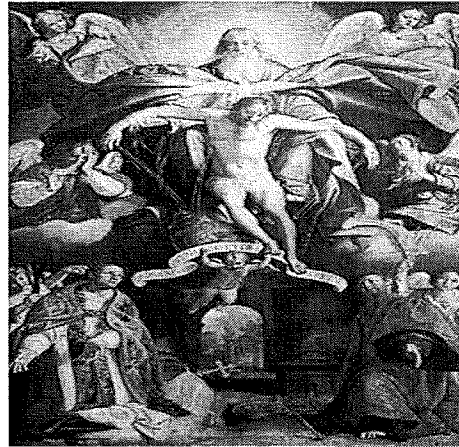

From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

There are items I am going to mention in this space today. First, tomorrow May 28, is Memorial Day. On this day we remember the women and men who died that we might live in freedom. Memory is a very important reality. Sometimes when we remember past events or people it is as if they become present again. This is what Jesus Christ means at the Last Supper when He says, "Do this in memory of me." We could say that Christianity is fundamentally about remembering Jesus Christ so well that He is not past but present. I hope that on Memorial Day we will remember the men and women who died for our sake and above all Jesus Christ who died so that we might live eternally. Second, next Sunday, June 3, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. This is also the day designated within our diocese for the (re) commissioning of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. That ritual will take place during all the Masses next Sunday. On this day we rejoice in the gift of the Body and Blood of Christ and also remember that as members of the Body of Christ each of us has the responsibility of giving Christ to others. Finally, as I leave there are many items which I do not want to take with me. Mostly these are books- history, biography, some novels. These books will be placed on tables in one of the garage door bays at St. Paul and are free for the taking. There will also be cigar boxes and a bicycle with some bike accessories. The garage door will be open during regular office hours. Again, I am not selling these items, but giving them away. You will be doing me a favor if you take them.

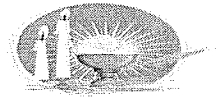
Were you out of town last weekend?
