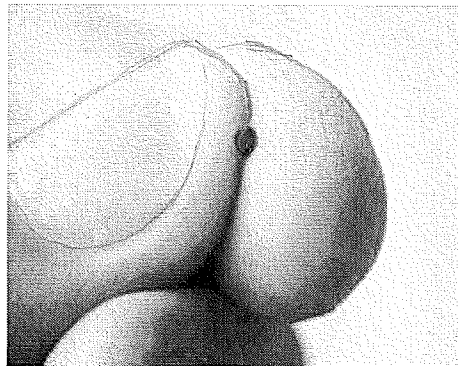

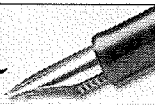
Mission Statement

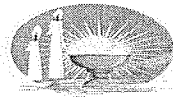

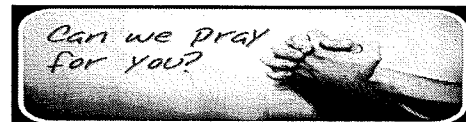

Dear St. Paul Parishioners,

Behind every cancer journey, there are compassionate people dedicated to helping. We are very thankful that you are one of those generous helpers. Thank you so much!

Already, your gift of \$416.73 is extending a caring hand. Through Cancer Services of Grant County, you're helping to provide things that make life easier for people facing cancer in Grant County; things like equipment, supplies, transportation, education, navigation, and more. Thanks to you, we are able to offer all of these things free of charge.

In 2017 we assisted more clients than ever before, 580 in fact! We provided 88 rides and bought gas 161 times so that clients could go to medical appointments. We purchased 116 prescriptions, and loaned nearly 2400 pieces of equipment and/or supplies. Our free mammogram program provided 200 mammograms and was instrumental in diagnosing one woman with breast cancer. 56 have been diagnosed since the program was started in 2000. None of these things would have been possible without the support of generous donors like you.

Cancer Services of Grant County is a local nonprofit organization that is 100% dependent on the generosity of this community. We are funded solely through private donations, fundraisers, and grants. We have 59 years experience in serving the needs of those in Grant County who are living with, living through, or living beyond cancer. 100% of your donation stays local to help local people.
