Today, June 24, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist. The fact that we celebrate this feast even when it falls on a Sunday indicates how important John the Baptist is. John the Baptist can be considered as both the last Old Testament prophet and the first prophet of the New Testament. His fundamental role is to help others to recognize and follow Jesus Christ. It is also noteworthy that John the Baptist is one of only 3 people whose birth the Church celebrates. As we celebrate this great feast let us deepen our commitment to help others know and follow Jesus Christ even when it is not "politically correct".
