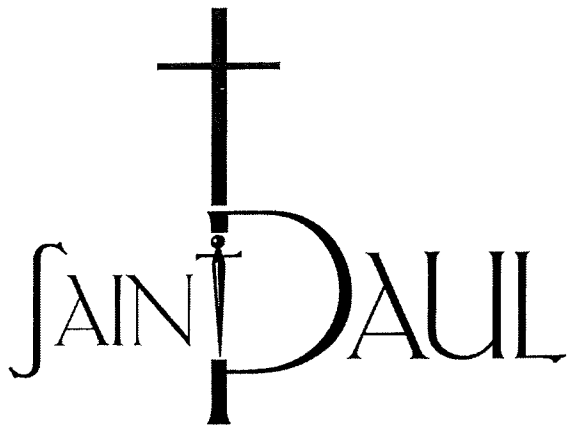

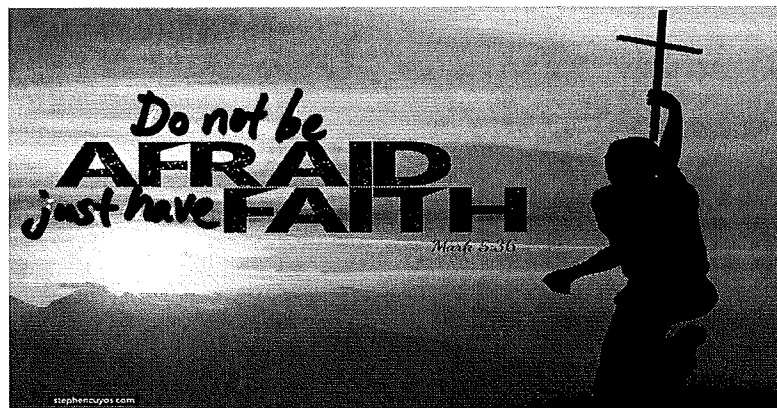

Dear Parishioners,

In April of 2017, I received a call from Fr. Weisenberger asking if he could come to Union City (where I was the pastor of two parishes at the time), for a visit. While the particulars of what we discussed had nothing to do with me coming to Grant County per se, I knew in my gut that I would be your next pastor.

I was simultaneously excited and a bit nervous. On the one hand, I was excited to be closer to family, friends, and brother priests as well as all of the opportunities for ministry that would await me in Marion and Gas City. After having been part of some wonderful things during four years of leading two poor, smaller parishes in Winchester and Union City, I was eager to have the opportunity to serve in a larger situation with a school and more resources. Knowing the priest that I would follow, I was confident that the fundamentals of the parish cluster would provide a solid base on which to continue to build up the Kingdom of God.

On the other hand, I was a bit nervous because I knew that this assignment would not be an easy one: a declining population in the county, ministry in both Spanish and English, a parish school, balancing two parishes and the highest number of Sunday Masses per priest in the entire diocese. I also knew that I would continue to be responsible for finishing an advanced degree in theology that would demand me studying about twenty hours a week for at least my first fourteen months.

My limited experience as a pastor has been that God can do wonderful things if we are open to moving forward and dreaming big. In four years, I witnessed a 25% increase in Mass attendance and a 50% increase in giving in an area with demographic trends that are similar to Grant County despite having to cut one Mass. Miracles happen when we ask for them with faith and are willing to cooperate with the workings of divine grace.

In the coming months, I look forward to the opportunity to get to know our two parishes better. Unfortunately, due to the work load of my three assignments (pastor, pastor and graduate student), I will be unable to accept dinner invitations during my first year here. I will have to invest a lot of time acquiring a better sense of my surroundings in these two new assignments-- getting to know Grant County, the parish staff, the school and the members of the parish finance and pastoral councils so that we can begin to form a vision for the future.

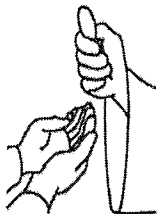
