Dear parishioners,

This week I would like to share some biographical information about myself. All of us are aware that getting to know someone means learning to go deeper than superficial information like birth place, family data, education and work experience. At the same time, one has to start somewhere.

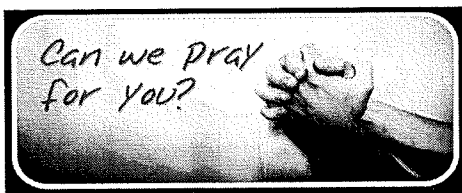
I am the youngest of six children and spent the first eighteen years of my life in Logansport, Indiana. I went to a parochial school until the ninth grade. My father dropped out of high school to marry my mother and eventually worked the night shift for many years as an industrial plumber at an auto plant in Kokomo. My mother was a homemaker until I was three, when she began studying nursing. She started working as a registered nurse when I was in the third grade. One of my strongest childhood memories from mother's college years was how much I disliked her green chemistry book because she always seemed to have her nose in it and I could never get her attention at those times.

After graduating from Logansport High School in 1997, I attended Harvard University, where I double majored in History and Comparative Religion. During my years in Massachusetts, I unexpectedly began to feel the stirrings of a vocation to the priesthood. Upon graduating, I went to seminary for six years, four of which were spent in Rome. I was ordained in 2007 and served in several parishes before becoming a pastor in Union City and Winchester for four years. Spanish is my second language and I have been involved in Hispanic ministry in some form for most of the last twenty years.

During my years as a pastor in Randolph County, I started working on an advanced degree in theology at the University of Dayton. I took on studies in order to help Bishop Doherty satisfy a Vatican office that instructed him that our diocese needed to have some priests with advanced degrees in theology. This assignment to complete my studies will continue concurrent with being your pastor. Thanks be to God, I have completed all of my coursework in Dayton expect comprehensive exams (which I will take this week, thus my absence from the parishes from Monday to Wednesday). Still, the academic element of my assignment will demand my attention for around twenty hours every week for at least the next year (None of my theology textbooks are green!).

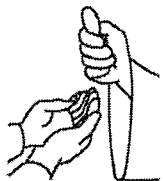
