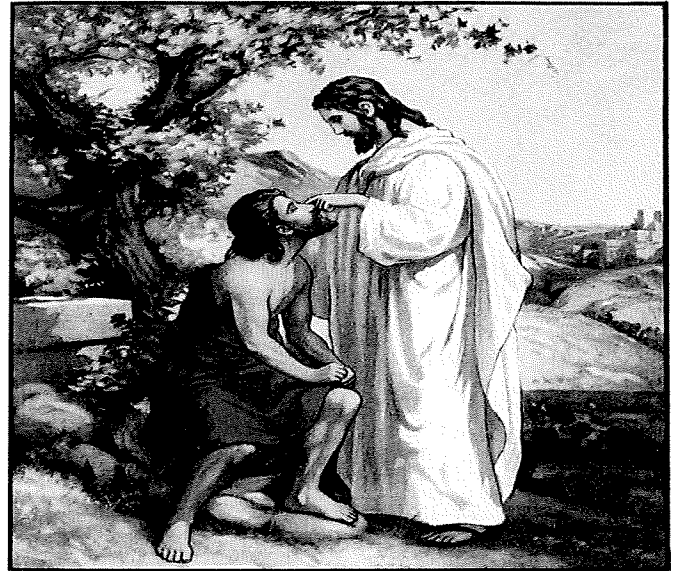

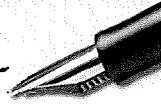

From the Pastor



Dear parishioners,

There is only one priest assigned in Grant County. None of us are happy with this situation—least of all myself. I wanted to share a bit in this pastor's note what is a typical week for me as pastor of Saint Paul and Holy Family.

I try to spend 90 hours a week working on fulfilling my priestly and academic duties. In light of the extent to which I have fallen behind on my academic work already, I will have to dedicate 30 hours a week to study until at least this coming summer. That leaves 60 hours after time spent researching and writing for priestly work.

A priest should spend at least two hours a day in spiritual exercise (breviary, rosary, meditation, etc.) outside of celebrating Mass. That leaves 46 hours, 2 of which I spend in the confessional and 8 of which I use to celebrate Mass in an average week. The remaining 36 hours I split between the two parishes.

How do I spend these 36 hours? I try to spend 4 hours a week on school-related work. Parish councils (pastoral and finance) and everything that goes into them takes about an hour a week. We average two funerals every three weeks, meaning that I spend an average of three hours a week working on funeral-related activities. Staff and other miscellaneous meetings (K of C, liturgy committee, etc.) take an additional two hours a week, which leaves 26 hours.

Diocesan meetings, priest gatherings or other mandatory events outside of the parish probably average five hours a week on account of travel time from Grant County to Lafayette or wherever the meeting is (I will be honest and say that I skip more of these than I should). Homily preparation and writing this bulletin note should take at least four hours a week if I am doing them justice. I try to limit the time spent driving back and forth between Marion and Gas City, but I have not yet discovered how to spend below 2 hours a week commuting. Everything involved in holy day Masses and other special liturgical days like Holy Week probably average an hour a week.

That leaves me 14 hours a week for sick calls, responding to messages, making appointments for baptismal or marriage preparation and anything else that I have time to do. Obviously, emergency sick calls take highest priority. I will readily admit that I am neglecting many things that deserve my attention in these two parishes.

About RCIA? There is no set time-period for completion of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) process, but rather four stages: Pre-catechumenate (inquiry); Catechumenate (dedicated formation), Purification and Enlightenment (coincides with Lent and the Easter Initiation Rites - baptism, confirmation and Eucharist); and Mystagogy (Easter to Pentecost-for deepening of new faith).
