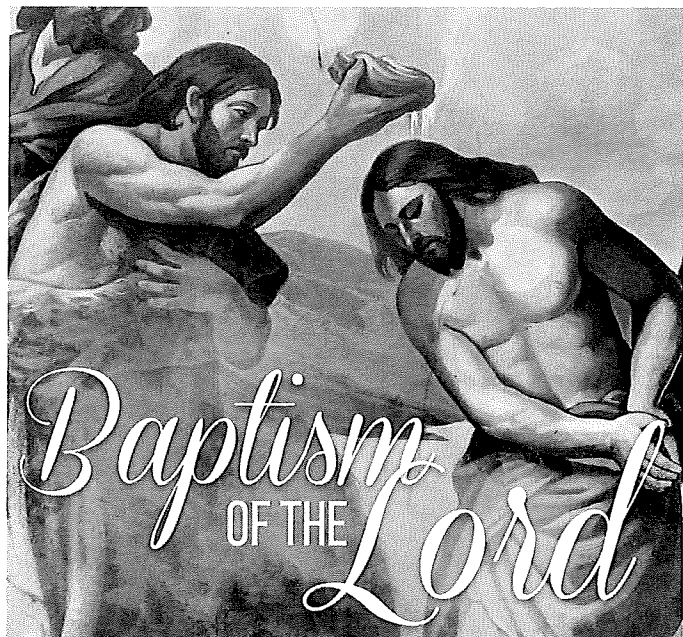

## From the Pastor



Dear Parishioners,

Last week I preached about the importance of preparing for the weekly pilgrimage to Sunday Mass throughout the week. As I have reflected on my own engagement in this practice, it struck me that I might benefit from being more intentional about this practice. Starting this week, I will post the times that I will be in Church making my daily Holy Hour in the presence of the Most Blessed Sacrament. We know through our Catholic faith that Jesus Christ is present under the appearance of bread and wine in the Sacrament of the Altar, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. This truth of the faith means that we are very close to our Lord when we pray before Him present in the Eucharist.

I invite you to join me either in the church at Holy Family or the Blessed Sacrament Chapel at Saint Paul. During this daily holy hour, there will be simple exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance. The times this week will be:
