From the Pastor



Dear parishioners,

Last week, I announced our upcoming parish cluster mission, "Mary's Hidden Gospel", being held at Holy Family on March 11th, 12th and 13th at 6:30 p.m. I will be giving the mission, which will focus on how Mary shows us the simplest, most direct way to encounter Jesus. The format for the mission on the first two nights will be a 45 minute talk followed by fellowship time in Reemmer Hall. On the third night, the talk will be about fifteen minutes, followed by an opportunity for individual confession. As in the previous two nights, fellowship will follow.

We will be asking people from different letters of the alphabet to bring a dessert to share on corresponding nights. Those who do not want to bring a dessert are urged to bring something fruit-related. We plan to provide child care for those below middle-school age, one for younger children and another for elementary school age. Volunteers are needed to help with child care. Please contact me at fr.croberts@dol-in.org if you are interested in helping with child care. Contact me also if you would like to help with publicity.

This mission is an ideal way to invite the unchurched, curious Protestants or lapsed Catholics to join us in a low-tension environment. It also provides a good opportunity to begin a personal plan of spiritual renewal. While one will get the most out of this mission by attending all three nights, the talks will be structured in such a way as to allow you to attend just one evening and still grow closer to Jesus.

This mission is an exciting opportunity for our parish cluster to come together to celebrate the love that God revealed to us through Jesus and to do so with the Mother of God as our guide!

Diocesan Commitment to Safe Environment

The Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana is dedicated to ensuring a culture that is safe, open, welcoming and protective of all people and especially our children.

We cooperate with parents, civil authorities, educators, and community organizations to provide education and training for children, youth, parents, ministers, educators, volunteers and others about ways to make and maintain a safe environment for children and vulnerable adults.

The Diocese makes clear to clergy and members of the community the standards of conduct for clergy and other persons in positions of trust with regard to abuse.

The Diocese will evaluate the criminal history background of all diocesan, school and parish employees, as well as volunteers who have regular contact with minors. Specifically, they will utilize the resources of law enforcement and other community agencies.

Finally, all employees, as well as volunteers with any level of contact with youth will successfully complete safe environment training on a regular basis.

How to Report an Incident of Sexual Abuse of a Minor

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse by a person working for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana, (such as a priest, deacon, sister, brother, lay officer, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

1. Call the Indiana Department of Child Protective Services (800-252-5400) and/or the appropriate civil law agencies as required by civil law.
2. Contact the Office of the Vicar General (800-942-2397) in the Diocese of Lafayette or the Office of Assistance Ministry (800-533-7018). Compose in writing a detailed description of the facts/incidents of the abuse and send it, as soon as possible, to: Mr. Max Layden, P.O. Box 909, Lafayette, IN 47902.
3. Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

Cómo denunciar un incidente de abuso sexual contra un menor

Si usted o alguien que conoce ha sido víctima del abuso sexual infantil por parte de una persona que trabaje para la Iglesia Católica-Romana en la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana (tal como un sacerdote, diácono, religioso, funcionario laico, empleado, voluntario, etc.) se le pide que denuncie el incidente de la siguiente forma:

1. Llame a la organización de protección para menores (Child Protective Services) o a los organismos judiciales civiles competentes, según lo exige la ley civil.
2. Llame a la Oficina del Vicario General (800-942-2397) o a la oficina del ministerio de asistencia (800-533-7018) de la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana. Redacte una descripción detallada de los hechos e incidentes de dicho abuso y envíela tan pronto como sea posible a: Mr. Max Layden, PO Box 909, Lafayette, IN 47902.
3. Posteriormente, la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana o un representante de ésta, llevará a cabo una investigación.
