## From the Pastor



Dear Parishioners,

Last Wednesday, we had a meeting at Saint Paul to discuss the specifics of the diocese's new pastoral plan. The biggest concrete change for the Church in Grant County will be that Saint Paul will now have its own priest and Holy Family will be sharing a priest with both Saint John in Hartford City and Saint Mary in Dunkirk. Apart from that, we discussed three very important points:

**Why is a new plan necessary?** What we have been doing as a Church in the United States has not been working for at least two generations. We are seeing the fruits of this reality in Grant County. Between 2000 and 2017, Mass attendance in the country decreased by 45%, which is about five times faster than the rate that the general population decreased. When we look around us at Mass, we see a disproportionately small percentage of people who are younger than retirement age.

**What does the new plan hope to accomplish?** The new pastoral plan aims at moving from maintenance mode, trying to keep things going without changing anything no matter what, to mission mode. In order to do this, it will be necessary for us to win people to the faith by becoming actively engaged Catholics. An actively engaged Catholic is one who gives of time, talent, and treasure and uses the tongue to build up the Church community rather than to tear it down, in order to experience and bring others to experience the healing and saving love of Jesus Christ.

**What will it cost and what about my favorite Mass time?** The plan envisions Saint Paul having three Lord's day Masses and Holy Family no less than one. It is possible that Holy Family will have Mass on a Sunday morning rather than a Saturday evening. It is possible that Saint Paul will have a Saturday evening Mass in place of one of its Sunday Masses. The additional annual cost to Saint Paul having its own priest and music director, and other mandated diocesan personnel changes should be at least \$30,000 (or about 5% of the average Sunday collection). At Holy Family, the number is harder to guess, but it is likely to be around \$25,000 annually (or about 20% of the average Sunday collection).

### **Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**July 14, 2019**

Deuteronomy 30:10-14. Psalm 69:14, 17, 30-31, 33-34, 36, 37. OR Psalm 19:8, 9, 10, 11. Colossians 1:15-20. Luke 10:25-37.

**Loving means acting.** In the First Reading, Moses pleads for us to heed the voice of God – it is not that hard. In the Gospel, a scholar poses two worthy questions to Jesus. How do I get to heaven? What do I do and with whom do I do it to get there? Jesus tells a story to provoke suitable answers. The good Samaritan, this good foreigner, puts the natives to shame. He has the right motive – compassion. It causes him to act with mercy.

- ♦ When will I set aside time each day to heed God's voice?
- ♦ What will I do and not do to keep my sights on heaven?
- ♦ Since to love is to act, whom will I treat with mercy today?
