Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Lawrence,

Since it is Pentecost, I want to share with you a few important scriptural passages regarding the Holy Spirit.

The passage from which we draw the gifts of the Holy Spirit: Isaiah 11:2 – “The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him: a spirit of wisdom and of understanding, a spirit of counsel and of strength, a spirit of knowledge and of fear of the Lord.” That makes six gifts. The seventh is “piety,” which is very similar to “fear of the Lord.”

Another passage that would be good to know is the one from Galatians from which we draw the “fruits of the Holy Spirit.” Gal.5:22 – “The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.”

To these the church adds “goodness, modesty, charity” – drawn from other passages. One of my favorites is the passage in Romans 5:5 – “Because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.”

If you ever struggle with prayer, the passage in Romans 8:26-27 – “In the same way the Spirit too comes to the aid of our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit itself intercedes with inexpressible groanings. And the one who searches hearts knows what is the intention of the Spirit, because it intercedes for the holy ones according to God’s will.”

In John’s Gospel, Jesus promises us the gift of the Holy Spirit to guide us. John 16:12-13 – “I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now. But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth. He will not speak on his own, but he will speak what he hears, and will declare to you the things that are coming.”

It is the gift of the Holy Spirit promised by Jesus that we trust is guiding us and helping unfold what Jesus taught His disciples as he “guides us to the fullness of truth.”

The sequence for the Feast of Pentecost is not from scripture directly, but is one of my favorite prayers which we all should pray frequently as we need it for ourselves, families and daily life. (See page 6 of this bulletin for the Sequence.)
