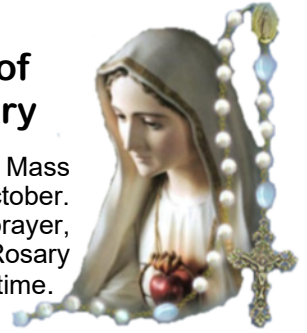
All Souls' Day Envelopes
