**OCTOBER IS RESPECT LIFE MONTH:** God is with us and asks us to be channels of His love for others. The Psalm reminds us that we don't need to face these trials alone or have everything figured out for ourselves. If we trust in the LORD and ask him for his compassion and love, he will not fail us. He is so kind and merciful that when we turn to him and make ourselves humble—as Mary did with her continual fiat—he will teach us how to follow him. And, as Ezekiel says of the sinner who repents, "he shall surely live, he shall not die." We have nothing to fear if we remain humble and open to what God has planned for us. Even if the future seems uncertain, God can transform any bit of obedience into his glory, where compassion and mercy flow. Showing the love of Christ to women who are considering abortion is one of the most sensitive, and most important, ways we may be called to witness to the dignity of each person. In these moments, we have the responsibility to respond in a loving way that is life-affirming for both the mother and her baby. We may be afraid of doing or saying the wrong thing, but we need to ask God to guide us and trust him.
