### BLESSING OF THROATS - FEBRUARY 2 & 3 ST. BLAISE PATRON OF THROAT ILLNESSES

Many Catholics might remember Saint Blaise's feast day because of the Blessing of the Throats that took place on this day. Two candles are blessed, held slightly open, and pressed against the throat as the blessing is said. Saint Blaise's protection of those with throat troubles apparently comes from a legend that a boy was brought to him who had a fishbone stuck in his throat. The boy was about to die when Saint Blaise healed him. The blessing of throats will be given during the weekend Masses of February 2 & 3. The blessing is a traditional sign of the struggle against illness in the life of the Christian.
