ASH WEDNESDAY: It's hard to believe that Lent is just around the corner... March 6th is Ash Wednesday.

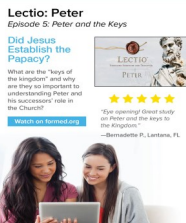
