HOW CAN I MAKE A GOOD CONFESSION? Jesus knew that, even after Baptism, we would fall into sin, so he instituted the Sacrament of Confession. In confession, we admit what we've done, apologize and resolve not to do it again. In return, we receive absolution and the grace to fight against temptation. "His mercy is infinitely greater than our sins" (Pope Francis).

A good confession begins with a thorough examination of conscience. Using the Ten Commandments and the Beatitudes as guides, reflect on the instances when you have failed to love like Christ. Confess any mortal sins since your last confession and any venial (less serious) sins that you remember. For sin to be mortal, it must be serious, freely chosen and committed knowing it was a sin.

After hearing your confession, the priest will ask you to make an Act of Contrition expressing your sorrow for sins and a desire to change. He will give you absolution and assign you penance. Remember, God loves you dearly and He wants to forgive you; you just need to ask.
