

The Shrine of Ars in France, which houses this major relic, has entrusted it to the Knights of Columbus for a nationwide U.S. tour. The Diocese of Bismarck and the Cathedral welcome this special opportunity to offer for veneration a relic of this patron saint of parish priests, whose holiness and integrity are a model for clergy and laity alike. On Tuesday, May 28 Mass will be offered by Bishop Kagan at 5:30 p.m. Veneration of the relic and confessions will begin after Mass and continue through the night until noon on May 29. Night Prayer will begin at 9 p.m. on May 28. On Wednesday, May 29, morning Masses will take place at 6:45 a.m. and 8 a.m. The Divine Mercy Chaplet will be recited after the 8 a.m. Mass. A rosary will be prayed at 11:30 a.m., with the Litany of Saints to follow. A closing procession will be at noon. Everyone in the diocese is invited to come and venerate this holy relic.
