The New Orleans Catholic Cemeteries Office is sponsoring a photo contest open to ages 9+ from April 1-June 30.



### PRIZES AND RULES:

- 12 winners will be chosen (3 youth, 9 adult).
- 1st place adult \$75, 1st place youth, \$75.
- 10 additional winners will receive \$25.
- All 12 winners' photos will be published in New Orleans Catholic Cemeteries' 2020 calendar with credit given.
- Winning photos also will be used on the office's social media platforms, with credit given to the photographer.



- The photo must be taken inside a New Orleans Catholic cemetery during regular cemetery hours.
- Those eligible sites are St. Patrick, St. Louis, St. Roch, St. Joseph and St. Vincent (Soniata St.) cemeteries in New Orleans; and St. Charles Cemetery in Luling.
- Entries must include the date and location in which the photo was taken.
- Photos may not be submitted with any logo, identifying mark or name on the facing.

- Photos that include people in them will not be considered.
- The photo must be original to the person submitting it.
- Employees of New Orleans Catholic Cemeteries and their families are not eligible for the contest.
