All Souls Intentions

All Souls Day will be November 2nd, and we will be having a very special service at Holy Angels to gather in prayer to remember the souls who have passed on to God. In a special way we invite those families who have lost a loved one this year and we will ask that you light a candle to honor their memory. For those who have passed in previous years we will ask that you write their name on a leaf and then hang the leaves on trees in the sanctuary for the month of November to remind us. Fr. Adrian will be offering a novena of Masses for all the names of deceased who have been listed on **ALL SOULS ENVELOPES** and put in the collection basket. A donation is welcome but not necessary for these Masses. Please plan on attending November 2nd at 7PM for the All Souls Service and filling out one of the envelopes so that your deceased are remembered in the novena of Masses. This is an ancient custom of the church for a variety of reasons:

1. We are taught that people who have died can no longer pray for themselves so they depend upon our prayers for them.
2. We are taught that they can pray for us and in our remembering them they in turn pray for us.
3. In grieving a loss it is very important to remember the deceased, to refer to them, to speak to them as they were and still are very real to us even after death.
4. These traditions unite the church militant (here on earth) with the church suffering (those in purgatory) and even the church triumphant (those souls already in heaven.)
