## All Souls Intentions

Please remember to pray for all the souls remembered during our novena and during the whole month of November.

*A thought:* how wonderful it is that our faith believes and teaches us this charity of praying for the dead who have gone before us. Our Lady reminds us that if we pray for those who have died someone will pray for our soul after we have died. The doctrine of purgatory, which is that place between heaven and hell, is part of our faith and not an optional teaching. It is a "teaching of charity" which allows any of us who die not completely saintly upon our death to have great hope and an opportunity to make things right with God. Let us take on the obligation to release many souls during this month of prayer and thereby know that our own will be cared for in turn.

## Cemetery Closure

The parish cemeteries need to be closed as cold weather descends upon us. As the weather gets colder it is difficult for the grave diggers to endure winds and weather working and the soil itself freezes and gets too hard to dig. Our insurance covers liability in our cemeteries until actual ice is on the ground so physical access for visits to graves remains allowed until snow falls. Those who enter the cemeteries during the winter are not covered by our insurance and we do not recommend it at all. **There will be no further burials in the cemeteries until spring.**
