-Fr. Adrian met with the parish financial and pastoral councils January 24<sup>th</sup>. The agenda of the meeting was a discussion about fundraising and way in which we can move forward in bringing extra income into the parish. He also forwarded to the councils material from the Dioceses of Ogdensburg concerning our combined efforts with the diocese by way of Capital Campaign to bring some added income into the parish and the diocese. **The next meeting of the councils and trustees of the parishes will be on February 21<sup>st</sup>, Wednesday, at 6PM at St. Ann's Parish Hall.**

-We are proud and happy to report that the **new roof of Holy Angels Church has been paid for** due to the generosity of those who gave. **Thank you, thank you, and thank you.**

-The new **fee schedule of cemetery prices** will take effect on February 1. This was given to you in churches last weekend as an addenda to the bulletin.

-The rectory of Holy Angels is empty and may be used by local parishioners who are receiving guests in the area. A donation to the parish is appropriate if your guests use the rectory and this helps defray the expenses of keeping the rectory going throughout the year. If you would like a tour just ask Fr. Gallagher and he will gladly arrange that for you.

-There are rumors Fr. Gallagher is moving all social functions to Holy Angels. This is **NOT** true. Father looks at the occasion to take place and picks what is the best location to have it. The winter breakfast schedule was decided to take place at Holy Angels because that parking lot is easier for us to use in that the parking lot at St. Ann's is more difficult with ice and walking up the hill. We are also having some trouble with the bathroom facilities at St. Ann's hall and this makes going to Holy Angels more realistic. There will be occasions when St. Ann's Hall is more appropriate for others reasons.
