-Closing of Parishes News: Bishop LaValley and the Diocesan Council of Priests have granted permission to the requests for the closure and change of status of Sts. Joseph and Louis of France parishes to secular use. St. Alexis, already closed, will now also be included in reduction to secular use. To all who worship with us on this Easter Weekend we are very happy to welcome you and thank you for coming. There are a few things proceeding in the activity of our parishes which may be new to you and we would want to communicate these things to you at this opportunity.

1. The Diocese of Ogdensburg nor any parish community has the intention, in the closing of local parishes, to lose parishioners or to not provide for their spiritual care. This is why it is the presumption that when a parish is closed membership of its parishioners is provided for by the diocese. The individual parishioner has, of course, the right to request membership in another parish but must do so clearly notifying the parish they are merged with. And so...
2. If you are a registered parishioner at St. Joseph's in Mooer's your membership is being automatically shifted to parishioner status at St. Ann's in Mooers Forks due to the impending closing of the Mooer's parish.
3. If you are a registered parishioner at St. Louis of France parish in Sciota your membership is being automatically shifted to parishioner status at Holy Angels Church in Altona due to the impending closing of the Sciota parish.
4. If you are members of these closing parishes and choose to transfer your parish membership to another church then please let us know of your intentions so that our records are as complete as possible. Thank you.
